


Transportation Master Plan

- Next: Prioritization and Funding


Map 1 – Roadway and Intersection Improvements

Bridge Improvements

- Barracuda Boulevard Bridge
 - Under design by FDOT
 - Design and permitting complete in June 2020
 - Right-of-way Acquisition in 2021
 - Construction in 2022
 - FDOT funded with 25% City match
- 5th Street Bridge
 - Under design
 - Bridge span extended from 40' to 160'
 - Design and permitting complete in 2020
 - Construction in 2021
 - FDOT funded with 25% City match
- Both projects to have public meetings




Street Resurfacing

Transportation Impact Fee Study

- Will use consumption-based methodology
- Collecting more traffic data to properly determine the local adjustment factor
- Draft final study by June
- New rate schedule by August

River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization

- The River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for a designated Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA).
- The TPO's Metropolitan Planning Area includes all of Volusia County and the developed areas of eastern Flagler County including Beverly Beach and Flagler Beach as well as portions of the cities of Palm Coast and Bunnell.
