Causes of Homelessness

- Unemployment/poverty
- Family separation – Divorce/family disputes
- Loss of loved ones – lack of social and family support
- Untreated mental illness
- Substance abuse
- Domestic violence
- PTSD

Common Service Needs for the Homeless

- Employment
- Housing/shelter
- Mental health services
- Substance abuse programs
- Case management
- Food
- Health care

Common Challenges for Providers

- Lack of affordable housing
- Lack of space in shelters – more homeless people than available beds
- Cuts in health, mental health, alcohol and drug treatment services
- Not enough case management
- Poor communication – traditional mail, voice mail, email
- Law enforcement becomes the default provider

Categories of Homelessness

- **Episodic Homelessness**

- Persistent poverty is the decisive factor that turns unforeseen crises, or even minor setbacks, into bouts of homelessness
- Temporary
- Unemployment or DV

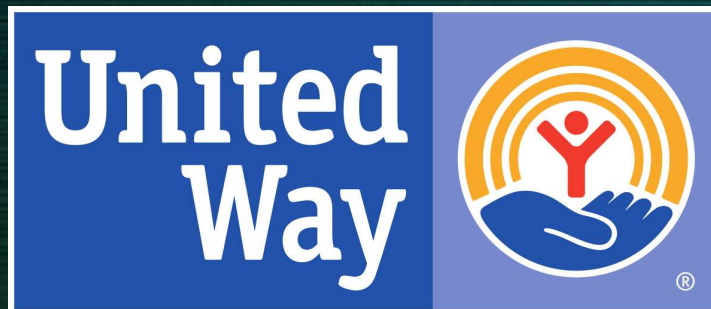
- **Chronically Homeless**

- Mental illness, drug and/or alcohol addiction
- Lack of financial resources
- Homelessness is a way of life

Health Care

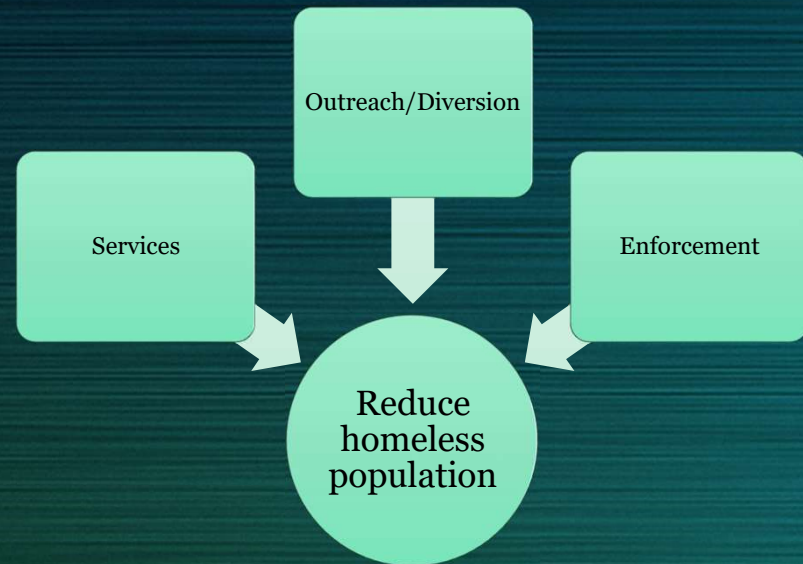
- Cannot get to medical appointments
 - Health cards, prescriptions, integrated health services cannot be reached
- Heavy burden of illness
 - Little access to medicine
 - Only way someone can get meds is through the Hospital Emergency Room
 - Very expensive and ineffective
- Infectious diseases
 - TB, HIV/AIDS, Hep C and Hep A

Whose problem is it?



How we address the problem

- **Educate** - about social services
 - Local providers
- **Encourage** - referral to those services through outreach and diversion
 - Case management
- **Enforce** - law and ordinances
 - Ordinances



Homeless Outreach Teams

A homeless outreach specialist officer and a case manager, working with various social service organizations

- HOTs are a bridge to services and not a social service provider itself
- Education about the social services that are available
- Referrals of interested persons to social services
- Diversion - transportation to referrals, shelter
- Enforcement when all else fails
- Data collection
