General Manager's Report

February FYTD reflects a \$0.9M loss due to lower capital contributions, increased operating costs and higher debt expense. **KPIs were all green** except for Safety & Risk due to 4 minor vehicle incidents

Counsel's Report

The FL Legislature is entertaining a bill involving placing regulatory rates on pole attachments for all municipalities to pay for 5G option for rural counties. Lobbyists are vigorously challenging it. **Another state proposal** would require all Central FL counties *except Volusia* to allow 40% of water supply to be removed for certain external entities that use water throughout the state.

New Business - All unanimously approved

- → Fiscal Year 2020 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, by the accounting firm of Purvis, Gray & Co, focused on long-term viability of systems. Concerns centered on operating income loss but pending rate study will alleviate this. Additionally, reserves should be increased from current 2020 level of \$5.7M/2 months to approximately \$7-10M/3 months reserve.
- → Amended/Revised Purchasing Policies and Procedures Manual allows use of electronic bidding as well as electronic opening of bids.
- → Agreement for Banking Services via Bank of America of Orlando re: the normal checking account/depository as well as credit card processing.

Commissioners Comments Commissioner Rick Hawes spoke approvingly of last week's joint UC & City Commission Meeting with Developers that was put on by the UC's management team.
