New Business

CA-1-22: 403 Magnolia Street (Woman's Club)

Mr. Alexander stated that the repairs for the Woman's Club building is now being divided into 2 phases, with the Phase 1 being primarily repairs to the foundation and Phase 2 being repairs to the structure above the foundation.

- Phase 1 has not gone out to bid yet.
- Projected completion of Phase 1 is 7/23.
- The timing of Phase 2 will be driven by funding from the state.
- Foundation plans are designed as if on sand even though some coquina exists below the building currently, but will not rely on it.
- There is a stairwell at the back that is not ADA compliant, but it is not public. The proposed plans keep the same footprint. Phase 2 would include reconstructing the access ramp into the main building.
- Some brick damage, would replace with same veneer as City Hall.
- Termite and water damage would be repaired in Phase 2 with some work done in Phase 1 to prevent further damage.
- 3 windows at back of building will need to be removed due to damage. Replacements are part of Phase 2 so all windows will match.

Motion to approve the Phase 1 Foundation repairs for the Woman's Club building was passed 5-0.
