## NSBPD Strategic Plan

- Phases 1-3 partially completed through FY21-22
- Phase 4 for FY22-23
- Complete staffing from previous phases: (2) Watch Commanders \& (2) Behavioral Health Specialists
- Add (2) sergeants and (10) police officers
- Phase 5 for FY23-24
- Add (2) sergeants and (10) police officers

Phases 4 and 5 will create additional patrol zones to split the city into 4 beachside zones and five mainland/west zones.

- Efficient division of workload
- Reduction of patrol shift overtime
- Justification based on current and projected growth adding to the demand for service
- Funded partly by Impact Fee Fund
- Impact Fee Fund to cover vehicles, uniforms and equipment
- General Fund to cover salaries and benefits


## Vehicle status

- Currently 66 vehicles
- Oldest vehicle is 2011. Nearly $1 / 2$ of the fleet is 7 years old and older.
- 16 vehicles are over 100,000 miles. Maintenance for these vehicles totals $\$ 331,586.65$.
- 10 additional vehicles will reach 100,000 miles within 6 months
- We have received no patrol vehicles in FY21-22. 9 remain on order with no projected delivery dates.
- Fleet replacement plan


## 2022-2023 Budget Requests

Capital -

- Vehicles: 9 Marked patrol vehicles - \$540,000*

2 Unmarked vehicles - \$80,000*
Impact Fee/Trust Fund -

- Strategic Plan personnel increases - 2 watch commanders, 2 sergeants, 10 police officers
- Establish Marine Unit - \$500,000* - FIND grant and Impact Fee Fund
- Cold case investigation - \$75,000 - LE Trust Fund
- Operating - No additional requests in FY22-23
