In this clip, Greg Holbrook, Executive Director of the New Smyrna Museum of History, briefly describes the movement of Woman's Clubs in Florida that led to its establishment in NSB in the early 1920s and the decision to build the property at 403 Magnolia.

Restoration of the building, now The Magnolia, is progressing quickly. In the next few months, new stucco will be applied, the tile on the outside entryway repaired, and an ADA ramp and entry will be installed. Meanwhile, interior detail work continues.
